







Jobs Management

'Jobs Management' gives an overview of the status of jobs and helps you plan work, by grouping different types of assets allocated to engineers.

This guide includes: Status Bar, Job Status, Job Types, and Selecting an individual customer.

1. Status Bar

This allows you to filter the information by the current status of the job.

Status

Any	TBC Quoted	iny	Scheduled	Started	Complete	Checked	Published	Void	
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2. Job Status

Status	Description	
ТВС	Not scheduled and no Quote Number was entered	
Quoted	Not scheduled but the Quote Number entered	
Scheduled	Scheduled, with or without a Quote Number. Visible to engineers	
Started	Started by an engineer	
Complete	Completed by an engineer	
Checked	Check is complete, which is the process that updates schedules	
Published	Job has been published and the customer invoiced, if appropriate.	
Void	Job was not completed but is retained for history	

TIP! Please note that jobs with a status of Published or Void are deemed complete and only accessible when viewing jobs for a specific customer.

3. Job Types


Job Types	Description	
Scheduled	A list of planned work converted into a job to be completed	
New Job (Call Out)	A custom one-off job	
Workshop Return	A job created to deliver and install Workshop Jobs which are Ready to Send.	
Calibration	A job to calibrate assets	

TIP! A job is only available to engineers once Scheduled and until Completed. A job cannot be deleted once transferred to the mobile system and editing is limited once started.

4. Selecting an individual customer

Click the "All Customers" field to narrow the search to individual customers.


Start typing in the name then select the correct option.



You can then use the status bar to filter further.

Summary information for the selected row is displayed in the multi-tab panel.

A context-sensitive menu that provides access to all eligible functions against a job.



TIP! Just above the detail panel is a smart button representing the most likely action based on the job status. New bespoke tabs or functionality can be added to meet your requirements.
